

ORDINANCE NO. 509

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PROTECTION OF THE PUBLIC AND BEAUTIFICATION OF THE CITY OF POCAHONTAS, ARKANSAS, AND FOR ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POCAHONTAS, ARKANSAS:

SECTION I: That the City Council of the City of Pocahontas, Arkansas, feels it is in the best interest of the City of Pocahontas that certain rules and regulations concerning the beautification and the protection of the public of the City of Pocahontas be implemented.

SECTION II: That the following rules and regulations are immediately placed into effect:

- (A) There are to be no refuse or trash cans, containers, or receptacles of any kind left or remaining on the streets, sidewalks, or curbs of the City of Pocahontas beyond the date that the trash or garbage is collected and removed by the Sanitation Department.

SECTION III: That any violation of the above described provision shall constitute a violation and be punishable at a fine of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00).

THEREFORE, this Ordinance being necessary for the safety of the public and beautification of the City of Pocahontas, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
